

IF YOU DON'T ATTEND ONE OF THESE BRIEFINGS YOU WILL NOT RECEIVE ACCESS TO THE TRACKSIDE OR PITLANE DURING THE WEEKEND.

TV CREWS

All TV crews must receive prior permission to film.

All cameras **MUST** carry a camera sticker which is obtained from the FIA Media Delegate. No filming is allowed anywhere on the circuit without this camera sticker or TV tabards.

TV news crews may broadcast a maximum of 90 seconds of race footage without prior authorisation.

IMPORTANT: Permission to use more than 90 seconds of race footage or for non TV news crews to film must be sought from the rights holders and a rights fee of £250/€250 may be payable. Please check with the Media Delegate prior to the race weekend.

All TV Crews must wear TV photo tabards - with the exception of the person in front of the camera (presenter/reporter). **A deposit of £20 or €20 is payable per tabard.**

Press Conferences

Press conferences will be held in the Media Centre. The FIA GT3 European Championship will hold press conferences after qualifying and each of the two races.

Media Car Park (see map on previous page)

The car park indicated is available to all members of the media, as well as staff and teams. Please ask at the Media Accreditation Centre for a car pass when you collect your weekend pass. All season pass holders will receive a season car pass which will be valid at all events.

Circuit Media Shuttles

There is a regular media shuttle that runs around the circuit perimeter road during the event. The start and finish times for this service will be posted on the notice board in the media centre.

PHOTOGRAPHER RED ZONES

The map below shows the areas that are off limits to photographers and TV crews. Do not attempt to take pictures from the red zone areas.

Pass Levels

The level of the pass you have been issued is indicated on your acceptance letter. Each publication will be issued with one pitlane access pass, but this pass can be swapped between the members of the publication's team. This is to minimise the number of media in the pitlane.

Security and Practical Information - IMPORTANT

PLEASE READ THIS INFORMATION CAREFULLY.

1. TABARDS

Race by race passholders working trackside or in the pit lane must wear a TABARD with ID number.

Tabards MUST be worn. DO NOT tuck them in your belt.

Tabard Numbers MUST be visible at all times. Photographers must not wear camera backpacks or put their own photo vests on top of the event tabards.

2. RED ZONES

The red zone map can be found on page 6 of this document

Even if an area is not classified as a Red Zone, you must make your own assessment whether it is safe to stand in that area or not.

The FIA Race Director can add a Red Zone at anytime if he deems an area to be unsafe.

3. SECURITY BARRIERS

YOU MUST HAVE A BARRIER BETWEEN YOU AND THE TRACK AT ALL TIMES WHEN THE TRACK IS LIVE.

It is forbidden to lean on, or over, the barriers. You may not cross these barriers, or place your cameras on these barriers. Do not stand in breaks in the barriers.

You must not stand in front of any debris fences unless authorised to do so.



In both these images the photographers in the green tabards are NOT acting in accordance with these instructions.

4. PITLANE

The pit-lane is a place of work, and can be dangerous.

PITLANE PASS: You may only access the pitlane if you have a **PITLANE** pass

PITWALL PASS: You may not stand on the pit wall or under the wall unless you have a **PITWALL** pass.

Wear sensible clothing. Shorts, skirts and open-toed shoes are not advisable when working anywhere on the circuit. However the pitlane is a working area and a dangerous environment. Anyone wearing inappropriate clothing will be refused access to the pit lane during all FIA GT3 European Championship and support race sessions.

FIRE PROOF SUITS ARE NOT MANDATORY BUT YOU MAY WEAR THEM DURING THE RACE. HOWEVER ALL MEDIA MUST WEAR LONG TROUSERS AND CLOSED SHOES WHEN WORKING IN THE PITLANE (no shorts, skirts or open toed shoes).

Anyone seen working in the pitlane wearing inappropriate clothing will have their pitlane access withdrawn for this and all other SRO events in 2011.

Remain alert at all times. If someone is waving a pit board in front of you, a car is almost certainly coming up behind you. Get out of the way! Remember that cars want to leave as soon as possible after their stops. Be aware of this, and move to the back of the car rapidly.

5. PARC FERME

Parc Fermé is out of bounds to the Media.

6. PODIUM

The only photographers allowed on the podium are the host TV cameraman, the Official photographer of the circuit and the official photographer of the Championship.

7. VIDEO

A photographer's pass only grants you the right to take still pictures; you cannot take video images on a DSLR with an HD Video Function without permission.

8. MARSHALS

Obey all instructions from the marshals and officials, they are there for your safety. In case of problems, please do not attempt to solve problems yourself, but report them to the FIA Media Delegate or the National Press Officer.

9 : TV CAMERAS

All TV crews must have a CAMERA STICKER on each camera and the cameraman must wear a TABARD.
